Kids Sewing Level 1

Start Date: February 19-23 2024

OVERVIEW

In this ~15-hour course students will learn how to thread and operate a sewing machine as well as begin to understand sewing terminology and techniques. Students will be able to learn a variety of sewing techniques through a multitude of projects. Students will design, cut, sew and assemble a tote bag, eye mask and/or PJ Top & PJ Pant.

GOALS & OBJECTIVES

1. Students will be able to learn how to thread a sewing machine and use basic stitching techniques, if they have no previous sewing knowledge
2. Students will be able to create their own eye mask, tote bag, and/or PJ Pants/shorts with matching to. Additional projects also planned if time permits.
3. Students will design their own product from conception, to pattern, to final product. Students will use a print out or fashion template (croquis) to sketch their own garment and direct students to their final fabric selection.

SPECIFICATIONS

This class has been designed to accommodate a five-day half day camp session. Each day has been broken down to 5 hour class, inclusive of two snack and/or lunch breaks through the class.
